Penelope Thwaites has performed and broadcast in over twenty-five countries on five continents. She has appeared as soloist with the Philharmonia, the London Philharmonic Orchestra, City of London Sinfonia and the BBC Concert Orchestra, among others. Her solo recitals in a wide repertoire continue to win high praise.

She is recognised world wide as a leading exponent of Percy Grainger's music, with an unequalled experience of recording and performing this fascinating repertoire. A compelling artist in both music and words, she has revealed a world of Grainger's music that is largely unknown. 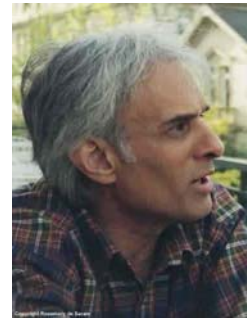
